In return for the opportunity to participate in this program, I agree for myself and for my heirs, assigns, executors and administrators to release, waive and discharge any legal rights I may have to seek payment or relief of any kind from the Town, its employees or its agents for injury, illness or death resulting from this program. If I am registering a child for a program, I agree that I am a parent, legal guardian, or am otherwise responsible for the child whose application I am submitting and that I release, waive, and discharge any legal rights that I may request on behalf of the child participation in the program. I also agree not to sue the Town, its employees or its agents and agree to indemnify the Town for all claims, damages, losses, or expenses, including attorney's fees, if a suit is filed concerning an injury, illness or death to me or my child resulting from participation in the program. I understand that the Town of Selma provides no insurance coverage for me. I have read this document thoroughly and understand that by signing this form I am waiving legal rights.

## **Trip Information**

### Reservation Policy

Trip reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis with payment and completed registration form. Spaces are only reserved when a payment has been received!

### Transportation

Charter motor coach or SPRD vans. Type of vehicle will be decided based on enrollment for each trip.

### Cancellation Policy

Full or partial refunds will be made only if a replacement can be found, and are subject to non-refundable expenses incurred by the SRPD. If the SPRD cancels a trip, a full refund will be given. Occasionally, unforeseen circumstances or events beyond our control may occur during a trip, resulting in modification of trip itineraries. **“No Shows” for trips will receive no refund.**

### Other Notes

- Trips will run rain or shine. Please bring umbrella and/or rain coat if necessary.
- Please dress appropriately and wear comfortable shoes. Bring along a sweater or light jacket for theatre trips in case it is cold inside.
- The bus will leave promptly at the departure time stated for each trip.
- Our departure location for all day trips will be at the Selma Train Depot (500 E. Railroad Street).
